Duration of the Course

The total duration of the course will be of two academic years having first year for Part-I and second year for Part-II.

Examination

The medium of examination is either English or Bangla. A total of 800 marks is allotted equally for each of the eight papers. Thus, both Part-I and Part-II consist of 400 marks each. The distribution of marks is given below :
